COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will prepare the student to engage in effective evangelism and multi-faceted outreach from across the street to the nations of the world. Missions will be examined from a historical, scriptural and practical perspective. Traditional, modern and new apostolic models will be analyzed for both short term and long term effects. An emphasis will be placed on understanding cultural differences from local neighborhoods to distant lands and in developing the communication skills necessary to effectively demonstrate the Gospel of Christ to all the world.

OBJECTIVES

To learn the basic methods and models of evangelism on the local, national and international mission field. To understand and develop a team mentality, which is essential to all successful outreach efforts. To become familiar with the FCM vision for missions and prepare for both Home and Foreign Missions trips in the near future. To fulfill the great commission that Jesus has given the Church.

1. Learn to determine when religious and cultural traditions are right, wrong or simply different from our own
2. Learning to make cultural adjustments in our lives and outreach efforts
3. Develop an apostolic approach to outreach ministry
4. Basic training in the practical aspects of traveling mission work: gathering the necessary paperwork, packing, security, health issues, sanitary issues, proper wardrobe as well as spiritual preparation
5. Be able to plan and organize a group mission from concept to completion

COURSE REQUIRMENTS
